a) Why Was the Internet Society Created?

The Internet Society, also known as ISOC, was founded in 1992 by Vint Cerf and Bob Kahn, two of the most important people in the history of the internet. The main reason it was created was to support the growth and development of the internet as a global infrastructure that is open and accessible to everyone. Before ISOC existed, organizations like the IETF (Internet Engineering Task Force) and IAB (Internet Architecture Board) had no legal or official structure, so ISOC was also established to give them a proper organizational home and legal protection.

In general, ISOC was created to make sure the internet keeps developing in a way that benefits all people, not just governments or big companies. It works on things like internet standards, public policy, security, and making sure people around the world can access the internet. It is a non-profit organization and its mission is basically to keep the internet open, secure, and available for everyone.

b) Nearest Local Chapter and Its Website

Since I am located in Northern Cyprus, the geographically closest ISOC chapter to me is the Turkey Chapter. The website address of this chapter is: <https://isoc.org.tr>

When I visited the website, I could see that the Turkey Chapter is relatively new and still building up its content. However, based on what is described on the main ISOC website, chapters like this one organize educational events about internet-related topics such as cybersecurity, network neutrality, and digital access. One of the key activities the Turkey Chapter provides is public awareness programs to help people understand how the internet works and how to stay safe online. These events are open to both members and the general public.

c) How to Join, Cost, and Recommendation for Beginning Web Developers

Joining the Internet Society is very simple. You just go to internetsociety.org, click on the "Become a Member" section, and fill out an online registration form. The whole process takes only a few minutes. Once you sign up, you can also choose to join a local chapter in your region.

As for the cost, individual membership in ISOC is completely free. There are no monthly or yearly fees at all, which makes it easy for students and beginners to join without any financial concern.

I would definitely recommend that a beginning web developer join the Internet Society. First of all, since it is free, there is nothing to lose. Second, ISOC offers free online courses through its Learning platform, where you can learn about how the internet works, internet governance, and online security. These are topics that every web developer should have at least some knowledge about, because building websites is not just about writing code it is also about understanding the environment those websites live in. Third, being part of a global network of over 150,000 members across more than 110 chapters worldwide is a great opportunity to connect with other professionals and stay updated on internet-related developments.
